Who was born the Twenty eight day of February A.D. 18 44 in

County of Windsor State of Vermont

I first entered the service at Elkhorn Wisconsin as private Aug 21st 1862. Joined Co J 28th Wis Volunteer Infantry.

I was discharged at Brownsville Texas Aug 23rd 1865 at expiration of time.

The first battle in which I was engaged was at Fort Pemberton Miss. Other engagements were (2) Helena Ark, (3) Duvalls Bluff Ark, (4) St Charles, (5) Brownsville Ark (6) Little Rock Ark, (7) Pine Bluff Ark, (8) Camden Ark, (9) Warren Ark, (10) Saline River Ark, (11) Spanish Fort Ala (12) Whistler Ala

I was confined in a hospital at Pine Bluff Ark the summer of 1864

Some of my intimate comrades were George Norton, Duncan Wright, John Matheson, Milton Parks, Geo. Faser, Donald Matheson, Stephen Conklin, Smith Hartwell
