Comrade John Wilcox

Who was born the sixth day of December A.D. 1845 in

County of Fountain State of Indiana

Enlisted Nov 5<sup>th</sup> 1861 at Morris Town Missouri as private in Company D 7<sup>th</sup> Kansas Vol. Cav. was promoted to Farrier of Co D.

Was discharged at St Louis Mo at expiration of term of service Dec 1<sup>st</sup> 1864.

Our first engagement was on the Little Blue in Mo Nov. 11—1861 Cavalry duty was Scouting and Skirmishing. Other engagements were The battle of Juka Miss. Sept-19-20-1862. Corinth Miss Oct-3-4—1862 Guntown Miss and Pontiac Miss. I was wounded in Apr. 1863 at Florence Ala, and was sent to a hospital at Corinth Miss. was also in a hospital at Juka Miss.

Some of my comrades names were Welcome Mowry, Saimon Lemon, John Wrotons, Edward Day, Jieut Downings, Nathen Hinsdale.
